**SECOND DOSE OF COVID-19 VACCINE TO BE GIVEN AT ATECH TO RESIDENTS PREVIOUSLY VACCINATED ON JANUARY 23, 2021**

The Ashtabula County Health Department will be holding a Closed Clinic for Ashtabula County residents who received the first dose of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine on January 23, 2021 at the Jefferson Elementary School.

Approximately 612 Ashtabula County residents in the (1B) Tier Group which included people 75 years old and older along with school staff members, received their first dose of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine on January 23, 2021.

Two doses of Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine are needed to complete the COVID-19 vaccination requirements.

Pfizer recommends that the second dose of COVID-19 Pfizer vaccine be given 21 days after the first dose.

The Ashtabula County Health Department will be holding the second Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine clinic at the Atech Campus B Building Complex from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on February 13, 2021.

At the clinic, there will be a separate entrance for handicapped residents getting their second COVID-19 vaccination shot. This entrance will be on the west side of the Atech Campus B Building. The entrance for non-handicapped residents will be on the east side of the Atech Campus B Building. All incoming traffic to this clinic should use the Garrett Road entrance to the Atech Campus B Building.

Appointment times for residents receiving their second dose of Pfizer vaccine are organized alphabetically by last name. Listed are the alphabetical time slots that have been established by the Ashtabula County Health Department for this clinic.

**Procedures for A-Tech Clinic**

- Ashtabula County Health Department will be hosting a COVID clinic Saturday February 13, 2021 between the hours of 9a and 4p.
- The clinic will be held at the Ashtabula County Technical & Career Campus (A-Tech) for second dose individuals who attended the clinic at Jefferson Area Local on January 23, 2021.
- The address to A-Tech is 1565 OH-167, Jefferson, OH 44047.
- Directions to enter the clinic are as follows:
  - \* Access A-Tech from Garrett Rd (Old OH-167).
    - 1) Continue onto Jefferson St Exd.
    - 2) Keep left to continue on Garrett Rd (Old OH-167).
    - 3) Look for tall blue health department banners for entrance.
    - 4) Entrance will be the first access gate from Jefferson St Exd which turns into Garrett Rd (Old OH-167).
    - 5) Turn left at the entrance where tall blue Ashtabula County Health Department banners are located.
    - 6) Consult with site security at the point of entrance for parking instructions.
- **Identify tall blue Ashtabula County Health Department banners for entrance to the clinic.**
- You will then be instructed as to how you will enter the building to receive your vaccine.
