



# Ashtabula County Health Department

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Health Commissioner

1. Positives = persons tested positive for COVID-19
2. PUI = Persons Under Investigation; Persons waiting for test results (assumed positive)
3. Probable = Persons exhibiting Signs and Symptoms NOT being tested. Being followed with contacts (assumed positive)
4. Symptoms Resolved = Persons removed from Isolation or Quarantine
5. Antibody testing = those not previously tested are considered Positive. Waiting on ODH for other results.
